

Pioke, the small rig shark, will guide you on Ngā Tapuwae o Tairongo (Tairongo's footsteps) around Ōhiwa Harbour. Pioke breed in the harbour and were important to local Māori in the past.



Choose your own start and end point.

Allow at least 2 hours to complete the entire trail.


